**Re: school closure by the EDB due to Swine Flu outbreak**

As I am sure you are all aware today the Chief Executive of the HK SAR, Mr. Donald Tsang, announced the suspension of classes in Kindergartens, and Primary Schools due to the increase in the incidence of the H1N1 virus. Therefore, as from tomorrow, (Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June) all students attending our Kindergarten and Primary classes will not be able to attend school.

Our school staff will be on duty and will be providing students and their families with learning activities for the duration of the suspension time.

The Education Bureau have indicated that schools will re-open on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June, but that they will be reviewing the situation nearer the time and will make a final decision a few days before the scheduled resumption of classes. We shall, of course be in close touch with the EB and will email you again as soon as we know of the date of resumption of classes.

As we expect all our students to complete the work provided for them throughout the two weeks, we are not anticipating lengthening the school term, therefore we shall still be finishing the term on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July at 12 noon. We would ask for the full co-operation of parents in making sure your child continues their studies at home. This work will either be available online from the school website, or as a pack which can be collected from the school offices from Monday onwards.

Finally I am sure you are as sad as we are that we have to close our school for this period, but the main thing is that all of us remain healthy and able to return to school again on the 26<sup>th</sup> ready to finish the school year on a high note!
