

Work for 23rd June

English- Write an entry in your diary and read an English book.

Write a poem which has an alliterative title and try to include some figurative language in your work e.g. similes, metaphor, or onomatopoeia (I need my class's help with the spelling of that word; feel free to underline and correct if I've got it wrong again.)

Possible titles – The Curious Cat; The Lonely Lion, The Wicked witch.

Remember a simile compares 2 things using like or as. For example, The little boy was as playful as a kitten.

Metaphor compares 2 things by saying one is the other. For example, My little sister is an earthquake waking up the whole house.

Onomatopoeia is a sound word. For example, crash!
Bang! Drip, drip!
