Contractions with Not

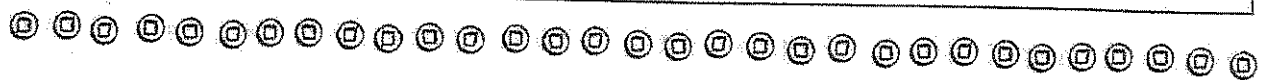
A contraction is a word made by joining two words. An apostrophe (') shows where a letter or letters are left out. Many contractions are made with the word not.

Examples:

do + not = don't

had + not = hadn't

will + not = won't
