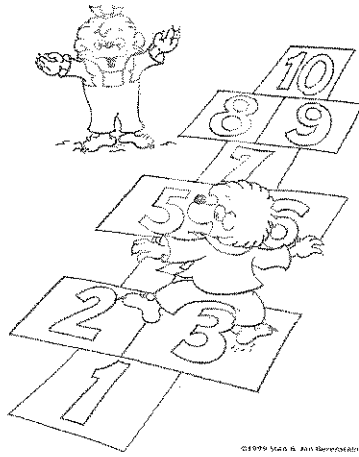
Teacher's instructions

ⓐ Draw something you do at 12 o'clock.

Hopscotch. What's the Time Mr Wolf?

Play **Hopscotch** indoors. Use masking tape to made the grid on the floor.



Play **What's the Time Mr. Wolf?**

1. Choose someone to be the "Wolf". The "Wolf" stands with his/her back turned to the others.
2. The others call out, "What's the time, Mr. Wolf?"
3. The "Wolf" turns to face the others and shouts a time in reply (eg. 6 o'clock).
4. The others takes 6 steps towards the "Wolf". The wolf will then turn his back to the group again.
5. The group shouts "What's the time, Mr. Wolf?" (The "Wolf" only looks at the group when he is shouting a time at them.)
6. Eventually the "Wolf" says "Dinner time!" Then the wolf runs after the group, who runs as quickly as possible back to the start line and hopefully the "Wolf" tags one of the group who will then be the "Wolf".
7. If no one is tagged then the wolf has to do it all over again.
